TFHA RECEIVES A ROSS-SC GRANT

We are thrilled to be recipients of the ROSS-SC Grant. The acronym, ROSS-SC, stands for Resident Opportunities to Self-Sufficiency-Service Coordinator.

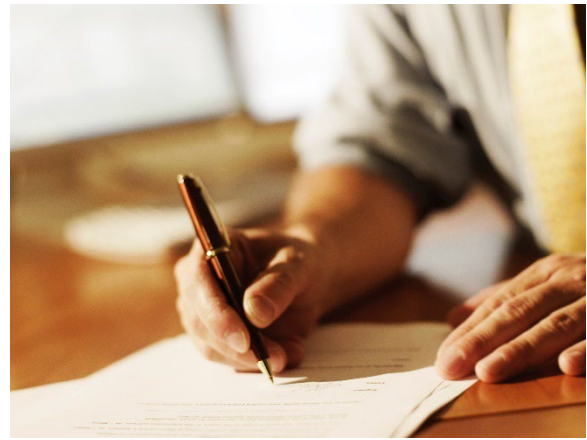
The grant award is for \$234,630 and will be spread over 3 years. It will cover employee salary and benefits as well as training and administrative costs.



The purpose of the grant is to connect residents with opportunities that may lead to self-sufficiency (i.e., schooling, training, budgeting, improving employment opportunities, etc.) and connect elderly and disabled residents to resources that may help maximize their independent living.

We anticipate a start date of June 1st for the coordinator who will be able to provide case management on a much deeper level than we have been able to do in the past.
